Parolee's arrested for multiple vehicle burglary.

Date: December, 15th 2011

Suspects: Johnny Hernandez - 22 years (parolee), Albaro Amaya – 27 years (parolee), and Corina Pennington - 27 years (arrest warrant).

Time: 0401 hours

Location: 1900 block of west of DeCarmen Drive

Victim: State of California

Summary: On 12/15/11, at approximately 0401 hours, officers from the Colton Police Department responded to a vehicle burglary that had just occurred in the 1900 block of west DeCarmen Drive. While responding to the area, officers were advised that a witness was following the suspect vehicle. Officers located the suspects and a short vehicle pursuit followed with the driver running from the car. Two subjects were detained at the vehicle and after a short foot pursuit, the driver was detained.

During the pursuant investigation officers located two vehicles that had been burglarized and one attempted burglary. Officers believe that more may have occurred and are waiting for additional calls. Suspects Hernandez and Amaya, who are on active parole, were placed under arrest for burglary and possession of stolen property. Both were also found to have active Department of Correction parole holds for parole violations. Pennington was arrested on her active county warrant. All suspects were later booked into jail.
