Woman gets attacked by vicious dogs.

Summary: On October 16th 2011 at 10:35 AM the Colton Police Department received two 911 calls in reference to a dog bite victim in the 200 block of east "O" street. The victim was a 31 year old female who was walking her two dogs on "O" street when she was attacked. The two vicious dogs were described as large American bull dogs; these dogs charged at the victim's dogs and began to fight with them before turning on to the victim. The victim received several bites on her leg and chest area, and after the attack the dogs ran back to their nearby residence. The victim was also walking with her 11 year old son who helped defend her by hitting the dogs with his skateboard; he was not injured. Colton Fire Department paramedics responded and the victim was transported to A.R.M.C. for her injuries. Colton Police officers removed the dogs from their residence, and the two dogs are currently being quarantined at the San Bernardino City animal shelter. The owner of the dogs was cited for several municipal code violations, and was given a date to appear in San Bernardino Superior Court.
