Drug sales at vacated residence.

Summary: The Colton Police Department received complaints from the neighborhood that illegal drug sales were occurring at 413 W. Mill Street. This property was alleged to have been vacant due to the owner recently passing away. Family members of the decedent also advised that property from the residence had possibly been stolen from subjects staying there without permission.

On 12/15/11, at approximately 1000 hours, officers from the Detective Unit responded to investigate and contacted multiple subjects at the residence. During the investigation three suspects were placed under arrest for different violations. Lori Baca was placed under arrest for maintaining a location for the use or sales of drugs. Nadine Jackson was arrested for possession of methamphetamine. Michael Romero was arrested for child endangerment. Child Protective Services was also called and assisted with the investigation. All suspects were later booked into jail on their charges.

Due to the location being in poor condition from the unauthorized occupancy use and no utilities, code enforcement officers responded and started the boarding up process.
