#### **Summary:**

The Cops-N-Jocks program and the Inland Empire Enforcers football team is proud to present the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Cops-N-Jocks Bowl which will be played on Saturday, March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009, at the Colton High School Football stadium. Kickoff will be at 4:00 p.m. sharp. This will be a full-contact game between The Inland Empire Enforcers and the Ventura County Badgers. Both teams include officers from local law enforcement and fire safety. The Inland Empire Enforcers includes players from the Colton, Redlands, and San Bernardino Police Departments, San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department, San Bernardino County Probation, Orange County Fire Department, and the Hesperia School Police. The Ventura County Badgers includes players from Ventura and Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Departments, California Highway Patrol, Oxnard and Ventura Police Departments, the U.S. Coast Guard, the U.S. Army, American Medical Response, and Gold Coast Ambulance.

Admission is a \$5.00 donation, however, any current high school athlete wearing their letterman jacket or jersey and all children under 12 years of age will receive free admission. This year will be even bigger than last year with more than 50 prizes raffled off, including a weekend for two in Las Vegas. There will be cotton candy and a Jolly Jumper for the kids as well as face painting by the Colton Community Services. Colton Police Chief Bob Miller will once again be the game announcer and the Colton and San Bernardino Police Departments will put on special K-9 demonstrations during half-time.

All proceeds from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Cops-N-Jocks Bowl will benefit San Bernardino County Special Olympics. Last year the first Cops-N-Jocks Bowl raised \$2,000 for Special Olympics.
